Program Fee Breakdown - \$300

- *\$150 per rower goes to the Brigantine Rowing Club for the use of their facilities.*
- *\$150 per rower food fee – this helps to provide food at the races for the rower and all attending family members and guests²*
- *Rowers can use fundraising to reduce the program fees...obtaining sponsorships is an easy method.*

Fundraising Fee Description

- *\$400 per rower – This fundraising fee can be paid outright or earned through participating in our fundraising “credit” program.*
- *In our 2016-2017 season, we offer the opportunities detailed on the next page to earn “credit” towards your crew fees.*

¹ Families with 2 rowers - fees are \$1000 = \$500 program fee and \$500 fundraising

² Fee covers the basics like breakfast sandwiches, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, chicken, hot dogs and drinks provided at the river during races. Families are also assigned side-dish type food items to bring on race days to supplement the food tent items. It is a rotating schedule.

- **Annual Sponsorship Program** – Collect sponsorships and earn 75% of the donation toward your crew fees.
 - Platinum Sponsor (\$500 donation) – Rower credit \$375
 - Gold Sponsor (\$300 donation) – Rower credit \$225
 - Silver Sponsor (\$200 donation) – Rower credit \$150
 - Bronze Sponsor (\$100 donation) – Rower credit \$75
 - Sponsorships are due by February 20, 2017 to earn Rower credit

- **Vacation Raffle**
 - Each rower is **REQUIRED** to sell a minimum of 10 tickets at \$10 each, regardless of your other fundraising efforts.
 - Selling of 10 tickets for \$100 will earn a \$50 “credit”.
 - Tickets are distributed in April 2017; ticket drawing date is May 25, 2017.

- **Flower Sale**
 - Each rower is **REQUIRED** to sell a minimum of 6 flats of flowers regardless of your other fundraising efforts.
 - Sell flower flats/hanging baskets and earn 50% of all sales as rower credit.
 - Flowers are easy to sell. The fundraiser paperwork is handed out in March and sales are due by April 15, 2017. Flowers are delivered Saturday of Mother’s Day weekend at the HSHS parking lot for distribution.

- **Bag Groceries at English Creek ShopRite – team fundraiser**
 - This first of this fundraising effort is scheduled for December 18th to help offset costs to attend Nationals which is being held at Cooper River Park, Camden County, NJ.

- **Applebee’s FlapJack – team fundraiser**
 - This fundraiser is a team fundraiser
 - Rowers must sell 5 tickets to the event.
 - Event date: February 4th - 8:00 am – 10 am. Applebee’s in Mays Landing.

Fundraising is how we work to keep rowers’ costs down. A secondary purpose of fundraising is to provide money to purchasing new equipment. Please do your part to help the team fundraise!!!
